Recalling that the Conventions do not prevent the Contracting Parties from offering greater facilities, at their discretion, to holders of ATA Carnets and their representatives, Mr. Mikuriya asked the Contracting Parties to think about ways of making the procedures more flexible ATA Carnets, keeping in mind that the delays in reexports are entirely due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

Such facilitation measures will be considered to be consistent with the updated WHO recommendations on international traffic in relation to the COVID-19 outbreak as well as with the WCO press release on the coronavirus pandemic (COVID -19), which seek to minimize trade restrictions for countries affected by the COVID-19 pandemic.

[1] Conventions relating to temporary admission, including the Convention relating to temporary admission (Istanbul, 26 June 1990 - commonly known as the Istanbul Convention) and the Customs Convention on the ATA Carnet for the temporary admission of goods, (commonly known as the ATA Convention).
